4. OUR PROGRAMS



I. Educational Program

In June 2021, LFAO established an educational center that offers English courses for children, with plans to expand into other subjects in the future. We are also preparing to provide courses for adolescents and youth, recognizing that education is a powerful tool for personal transformation. We believe that learning a new language can improve students memory, problem-solving skills, and even boost their creativity! And by equipping individuals with knowledge and skills, we empower them to change their own lives and shape their futures.

Our role at LFAO is to light the path to a brighter future, helping them unlock their full potential and create lasting positive change in their communities.



II. Healthcare Program

At LFAO, We established a medical Cabinet that is currently operating in Phase 1, providing dental services to underserved individuals. We believe that access to quality healthcare is a fundamental right for all, regardless of background or socio-economic status.

Our goal is to break down barriers to healthcare and ensure that everyone, especially the most vulnerable, can receive the care they need for a healthier, and more dignified life.



III. Community Service

LFAO aims to Serve the community by reaching out unserved villages to offer them better life through 2 parallel programs.

1. Medical approach: By Providing free medical examination, live savingcare services, medical screening, and free medication through three Campaigns per year, each lasts for one week.
2. Education approach: to support children with our additional interactive educational programs to make their minds active and elevate their hand skills.

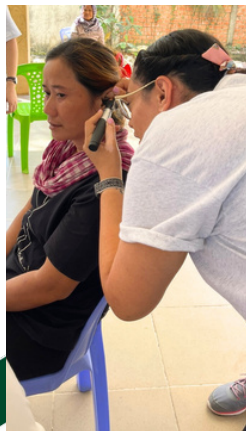
